Lucienne Diver writes Young Adult and Adult fiction, frequently with humor, but always with heart. Her latest release, ***Faultlines***, is about a girl whose world is turned upside down by her best friend's suicide. Lisa had pushed everyone away prior to her death, even her closest friend, Vanessa. In an attempt to understand, Vanessa decides to reconstruct the events that led up to it. Only someone calling themselves *Poetic Justice* thinks they know why Lisa is gone and starts taking revenge in advance of the facts. Others are sure that Vanessa must be *Poetic Justice*. As vengeance, counterattacks and clues mount, it becomes a race to the truth...and hopefully not to the death.

Faultlines is a novel very close to her heart, dealing with serious issues that are, unfortunately, all too prevalent today.

Her YA vampire novels (the ***Vamped*** series) feature a teen fashionista who goes from chic to *eek* when she wakes up as one of the undead, finding more humanity in death than she did in life. Her Urban Fantasy series (the ***Latter-Day Olympians***) present a heroine with more than a drop of gorgon blood, who can literally stop men in their tracks.

Lucienne gives both her series a unique spin, approaching the books with a healthy sense of the absurd and characters who know how to stand their ground.


